Join the amazing journey of sea turtles at SeaWorld Orlando in TurtleTrek.

From spring of 2012 SeaWorld Orlando will offer visitors the opportunity to experience the world's oceans from the perspective of sea turtles in a domed theater film. In <u>TurtleTrek</u> guests will first visit two massive naturalistic habitats, the first home to hundreds of freshwater fish and the gentle manatees, the second will showcase thousands of saltwater fish and more than a dozen sea turtles. Moving on guests enter a domed theater for an experience they have never had anywhere else! A first-of-its-kind 3-D/360-degree dome allows a hyper-realistic 3-D movie to be shown that is totally immersive and surrounds guests completely, not just in front of them, but behind and even above them! The movie TurtleTrek is shown twice, once each for the left and for the right eyes, each frame of the animated movie has 26 million pixels (more than 13 times HD), is shown at 60 frames a second and is beamed onto the dome by 34 projectors

Come Face-to-Face with otters and marmosets at Discovery Cove's new Freshwater Oasis

Opening in Spring 2012 at Discovey Cove the new attraction <u>Freshwater Oasis</u> will allow our guests to swim and wade up-close to playful Asian otters and curious, highly active marmosets in a relaxing tropical setting. Designed with a rainforest canopy above and sparkling-clear freshwater springs below Freshwater Oasis will allow guests to wade, wonder, swim and float through watery trails while experiencing exciting animal encounters in a unique new way!

Antarctica – Empire of the Penguin soon at SeaWorld Orlando

In 2013, SeaWorld Orlando will take guest on a voyage to the bottom-of the world, to the coldest and windiest continent, to a place of ice more than 3.000 metre thick. Guests will be surrounded by the sights, sounds and encounters found in this frozen place, embarking on completely new, one-of-a-kind ride for the entire family. Together they will experience the mystery and wonder of life on the ice through the eyes of a penguin. <u>Antarctica – Empire of the Penguin</u> combines closer-than-ever animal connections with state-of-the-art interactive ride technologies for adventures that are different each time you ride.
